

Our Preschool Program

The SCS Preschool Program provides a fun, educationally-based, and spiritually nurturing environment for children. Children learn about the wonders of God's creation through Science, Math, Language, Art, French, Music, and Physical Education. There is a daily recess time, snack time, lunch, and nap/rest time. Preschool students are invited to the big kids' chapel on Fridays and they also attend the SCS Elementary School's Spiritual Life Week in January.

Students engage daily in hands-on learning groups or centers that are purposely designed to provide multiple opportunities for them to explore and engage in conceptual learning. Class meetings or large group times reinforce center lessons and allow opportunities for students to share with one another and for the teacher to set a tone and vision for the class. Life lessons and social responsibility are taught daily as teachers consistently model and teach Biblical truth.



What Your Child Will Experience

Bible: learning Bible stories, memory verses, and attending Chapel weekly.

Circle Time: exploring the calendar, including days of the week, months of the year, seasons, and weather.

Math Activities: using a wide range of manipulatives to focus on graphing, sorting, and patterning as well as one to one correspondence counting and proper numeral identification.

Pre-Reading Activities: focusing on letters and sound recognition and listening to stories to develop proper sentence structure and emerging vocabulary skills.

Small Group Center Time: participating in various hands-on activities to promote color and shape recognition, and working with a variety of art textures and mediums.

Science and Social Studies: doing experiments, exploring the physical world around them and working with maps and globes.

Gym Time, Music, and French: participating in Physical Education twice weekly in the elementary gym, and engaging with Music and French teachers once each week.

Field Trips: taking one trip in the Fall and the other in the Spring.
